








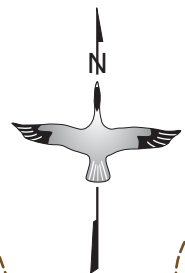

6. Lake view—invasive Chinese Tallow trees and Water Hyacinth
7. Box-elder Maple tree with Poison Ivy vine on the trunk
8. Shumard Oak tree
9. Carolina Buckthorn tree—small tree marked with a ribbon 15 foot off the trail
10. Osage Orange (Horse Apple) tree
11. Yaupon Holly shrub—female with berries
12. Grape vine on a pecan tree
13. Young Black Willow tree
14. Live Oak tree
15. Young Western Soapberry trees—one marked with a ribbon
16. Sycamore tree
17. Dead tree used by woodpeckers and other creatures—a number of young Pecan trees in front
18. Two large (bull trees—East Texas term) Pecan trees
19. Green Ash tree—in the water, now
20. Stand of Chinese Tallow trees
21. Yaupon Holly—female with berries
22. Live Oak tree with a stand of Giant Cane near it
23. Water Oak tree
24. Green Ash tree & Button Bush (in the water)
25. Sugarberry tree & Live Oak tree
26. Black Willow tree
