TRAIL GRANT APPLICATION

The Friends of Brazoria Wildlife Refuges are applying for grant under the 2009 grant program. The Friends, in partnership with the United States Fish & Wildlife Service, Dow Chemical Company and the Houston Galveston Area Council, are applying for a grant to develop an all-weather 1.7 mile, 6 foot wide loop trail that will include a crossing of Bastrop Bayou. The bridge shall be a prefabricated 100 ft span. This trail will be universally accessible and will include a universally accessible restroom, a parking lot, trail signs and six benches. The trail will be constructed on a recently acquired tract that was donated to the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service by the Dow Chemical Company.

The Friends are committed to provide \$2,100 and in-kind labor for this project. The Friends and our partners feel that this trail will become a great asset to our community and look forward to working with Texas Parks and Wildlife Department on the project.
