# Refuge Update – Jennifer Sanchez

- Closed on Yellerman Holdings 100 acres
- 19 acres in Gale Estates was put in a conservation easement This is Carolyn May-Monet property
- Freeport LNG purchased 500 acres. The southern end is going to be donated to USFWS it is the headwaters of a slough.
- Phillips 66 as part of a mitigation effort will conserve some property outside of the slop bowl. It will held by another conservation entity.
- Shane Kassen has accepted a position as Project Leader at Salt Plains Wildlife Refuge in Oklahoma and will be leaving by Nov. 1.
- The EE position will be full time for 9 months. It is open to all Government Employees until Friday Oct. 3. The requirement is a Bachelor Degree in Biology and 5 years of experience.
- The boundaries of Alligator Marsh have been altered for waterfowl hunting. It is open for hunting from dawn to 12:00 PM.
