

ADA-Compliant Concrete Trail

**Request for Proposal for ADA-Compliant Concrete Trail**

The Friends of Brazoria Wildlife Refuges is seeking bids for the construction of approximately 1,450 feet of six-foot wide reinforced concrete trail sections of the Bobcat Woods Trail located on the San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge. Approximately 1,330 feet of these sections will be a minimum of four inches thick, with the remaining approximately 120 feet to be a minimum of six inches thick. The concrete trail shall be finished with an embossed wood plank pattern and stained to match adjoining trail boardwalk sections surfaced with composite decking material.

As part of this same project, FOBWR is requesting bids for an adjoining reinforced concrete parking lot, 60 feet long, 60 feet wide, and a minimum of six inches thick. This parking lot shall be finished with a light broom treatment and stained the same as the concrete trail sections.

Contractors who are interested in bidding on the construction of the reinforced concrete sections of the Bobcat Woods Trail are required to attend a site inspection meeting to be held at the Field Office of the San Bernard National Wildlife Refuge, 6801 County Road 306, Brazoria, Texas on Monday, November 6, 2017 at 2:00 pm.
