ABOUT OUR REFUGES

The Texas Mid-coast National Wildlife Refuge Complex includes the Brazoria, San Bernard and Big Boggy National Wildlife Refuges, encompassing more than 116,000 acres. Public portions of the refuges are open daily, sunrise to sunset, at no charge.

The Brazoria NWR contains habitat for abundant species of wildlife in the marshes, sloughs, ponds and prairies. This refuge offers hiking, wildlife viewing, photography, hunting and fishing.

The San Bernard NWR offers a rich collection of bottomland forest, freshwater ponds, saltwater marshes and grasslands that support a vast array of flora and fauna viewable by auto tour and observation platforms. This refuge also offers hiking, fishing and hunting.

The Big Boggy NWR is a small sanctuary that protects important marsh habitat and a colonial water-bird nesting island.
