BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE APPROVED PROJECT, ANY SPECIAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO THE APPROVED PROJECT, AND /OR ANY MODIFICATION OF THE APPROVED PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to enhance 165 acres (+1300 non additive acres) and creation of 85 acres of estuarine emergent wetlands on the Sargent Unit at the San Bernard NWR. This project will also restore 2,000 acres of palustrine emergent marsh and upland prairie on the Brazoria NWR. The principal focus for this project will provide important habitat for the mottled duck.
